等待餵食的台灣獼猴

Formosan Macaques Waiting to Be Fed

台灣獼猴是有著高智商的特有種動物,人類的餵食情況嚴重,已讓牠們學到向人類搶食的惡習。為了保育牠們 冤於過馬路時遭受車禍意外,國家公園費盡心思建造一座獼猴天橋,然而高智慧的牠們至今仍不懂國家公園的 這份苦心。兩隻獼猴坐在「前有獼猴天橋」的告示牌上,仍等著人類餵食。**人們或許出自善意的餵食舉動,反而 在不自覺間造成台灣獼猴為了與人類搶食,弄得兩敗俱傷的遺憾。**

Formosan Macaques (*Macaca cyclopis*) are intelligent and endemic to Taiwan. Pervasively fed by humans, they've kept the bad habit of robbing for food. To protect them from being hit by vehicles when they cross the roads, the national park headquarters has houghtfully built a cross-over bridge for the macaques, which still haven't get the idea despite their high intelligence. In the picture, two macaques were sitting on the board written "Macaque Cross-over Bridge Ahead," and waiting to be fed. People feed Fromosan Macaques in good intention, but this feeding behavior has made them rob people for food and led to many frightens and regrets.
